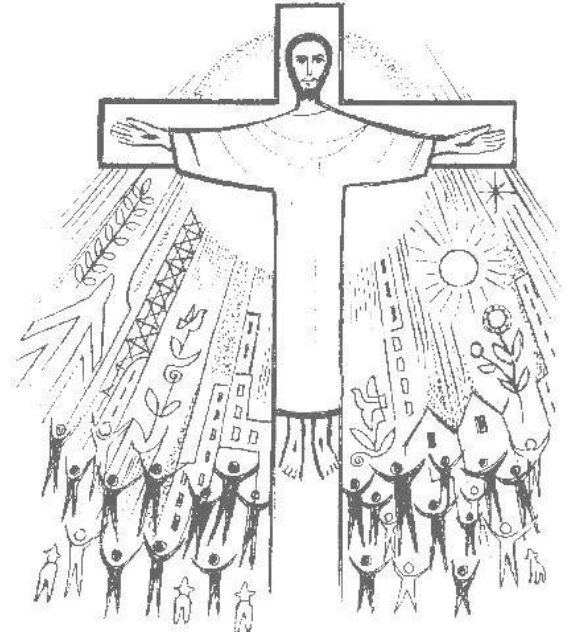

ALLELUIA (a celebration word)	DISCIPLES (the disciples were Jesus' special friends and followers)	LIVING (Jesus is still living today!)	STONE (the stone was rolled away from the tomb to show that Jesus had risen)
ANGEL (the angel rolled the stone away from the tomb)	EASTER (the word means 'dawn' or 'spring' and suggests new life)	MARY (Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of Jesus, were two of the women who first discovered Jesus was risen)	TOMB (after Jesus died, his body was put in a tomb. The tomb was empty on Easter morning.)
CROSS (Jesus died on a cross)	JERUSALEM (this story took place in the city of Jerusalem)	RESURRECTION (this means to rise from death to new life)	VICTORY (by dying and rising again, Jesus won a victory over death)
DAYBREAK (it was daybreak when the women discovered Jesus had risen)	LIFE (Jesus rose with new life to share with everyone, new life that can never die)	SALVATION (this means to be saved. Jesus' death and resurrection saves us all and gives us new life that's stronger than death)
